## CalculateTransitTime: Input Parameters

Parameter	Required	Description	Examples
<b>origZip</b>	Required	This value represents the origin ZIP code of the intended shipment. The <code>origZip</code> must be entered as a 5-digit US Zip Code, 5-digit US Zip Code+4 or an "ANA NAN" style Canadian Postal Code. Either the <code>origZip</code> or <code>destZip</code> must be serviced directly by PITT OHIO.	15226 15226-1625 M6E 3V4
<b>destZip</b>	Required	A string representing the destination ZIP code of the intended shipment. The <code>destZip</code> must be entered as a 5-digit US Zip Code, 5-digit US Zip Code+4 or an "ANA NAN" style Canadian Postal Code. Either the <code>origZip</code> or <code>destZip</code> must be a ZIP code serviced directly by PITT OHIO.	15226 15226-1625 M6E 3V4
<b>shipDate</b>	Optional	This string is used to indicate the date of the intended shipment and must be able to be converted to a valid <code>DateTime</code> . The <code>shipDate</code> must not be in the past and no more than two weeks into the future. The shipping date may not be a weekend or holiday. If a <code>shipDate</code> is not provided the current date will be used as the default date.	1/8/2013 01-08-13 01/08/2013
<b>verbose</b>	Required	A boolean value that indicates whether detailed or summary transit information is desired. When <code>verbose</code> is false the function returns the standard transit time, estimated delivery date and booleans indicating if the origin and destination ZIP codes are within the PITT OHIO service territory. When <code>verbose</code> is true, in addition to the summary information, the response will include details about the origin and destination terminal. If the ZIP code is serviced by a partner carrier, the partner's terminal details will also be provided (if available).	true false

## CalculateTransitTime: Possible Errors

- Missing destination ZIP/Postal Code.
- Missing origin ZIP/Postal Code.
- Origin ZIP/Postal Code is invalid or unknown.
- Destination ZIP/Postal Code is invalid or unknown.
- Origin and destination points are both outside of the PITT OHIO territory.
- Origin ZIP/Postal code ##### not serviced.
- Destination ZIP/Postal code ##### not serviced.
- Transit time cannot be calculated for the given ZIP/Postal Codes.
- Date is more than two weeks in the future.
- Date a weekend or holiday.
- Date is in the past.

Field Name	Type	Description
<b>Carrier</b>	String	The name of the carrier.
<b>SCAC</b>	String	The SCAC (Standard Carrier Alpha Code) is a unique two-to-four-letter code used to identify transportation companies. PITTOHIO's SCAC is "PITD". More information about SCACs can be found on the National Motor Freight Traffic Association's website, <a href="http://www.nmfta.org">www.nmfta.org</a> .
<b>TermID</b>	String	This code is a unique identifier that the carrier uses to identify their terminals. *
<b>Name</b>	String	The descriptive name of the carrier's terminal. *
<b>Address1</b>	String	The terminal's address. *
<b>Address2</b>	String	The second line of the terminal's address. *
<b>City</b>	String	The city in which the terminal is located. *

<b>State</b>	String	The state or province in which the terminal is located. *
<b>Zip</b>	String	The 5-digit US Zip Code, 5-digit US Zip Code+4 or an "ANA NAN" style Canadian Postal Code for the terminal. *
<b>Phone</b>	String	The local phone number for the terminal. *
<b>Fax</b>	String	The fax number for the terminal. *
<b>TollFree</b>	String	The toll free contact number for the terminal. *
